

Irving Flood Control District Section III Support for Irving Capital Improvement Program Delaware Creek Management June 26, 2019

Recently, local media updated city residents on a Capital Improvement Program (CIP) initiative of the City of Irving designed to improve stormwater management in a number of areas in the city located along Delaware Creek.

The areas in which improvements are being made have historically experienced localized flooding during major storms. This project will improve drainage at several points along the Delaware Creek Basin, helping protect 229 neighborhood structures and 10 bridges identified as being impacted by the current drainage model.

Coverage of the status of the project noted that none of the work involves any portion of Irving already protected by flood control districts, such as IFCD III. These Districts exist to protect property and people in known, larger low-land areas of the City and to exempt those living within the District boundaries from the purchase of individual flood insurance policies.
